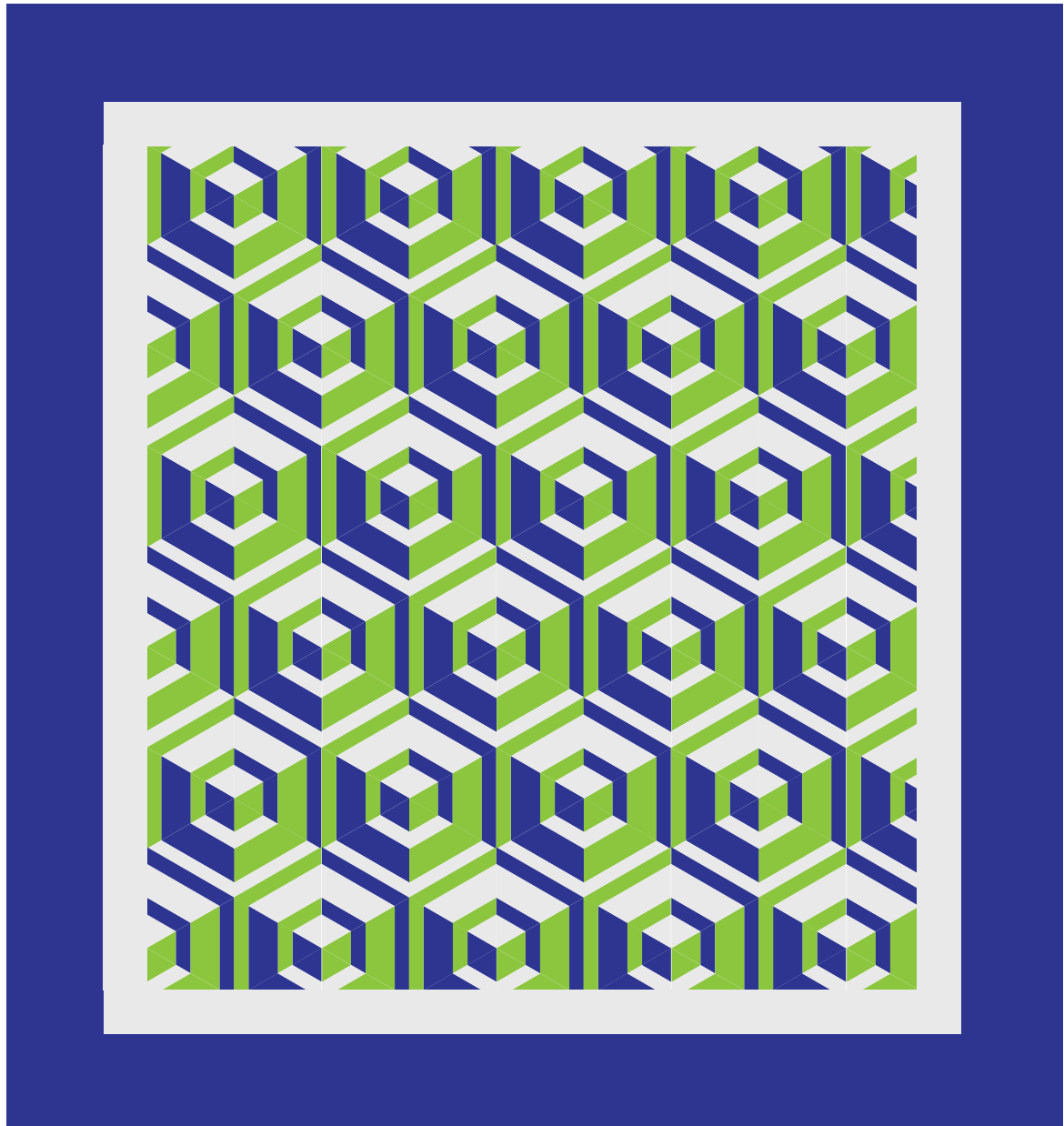




Sew Easy Quilt



Thank you for ! Here is some written instructions on how to create .

Materials

- Dark Blue: 3.5 yard
- Bright Green: 3.5 yards
- Light Gray: 3.5 yards
- Borders: 2.25 yards
- Backing: 2.5 yards 108" wide solid

Cut your fabric

- 32 Dark Blue 2.5" Strips (WOF)
- 32 Dark Blue 2" Strips (WOF)
- 32 Bright Green 2.5" Strips (WOF)
- 32 Bright Green 2" Strips (WOF)
- 32 Light Gray 2.5" Strips (WOF)
- 32 Light Gray 2" Strips (WOF)
- Borders: 2.25 yards
- Backing: 2.5 yards 108" wide solid

Piece Your First Block

- Start by

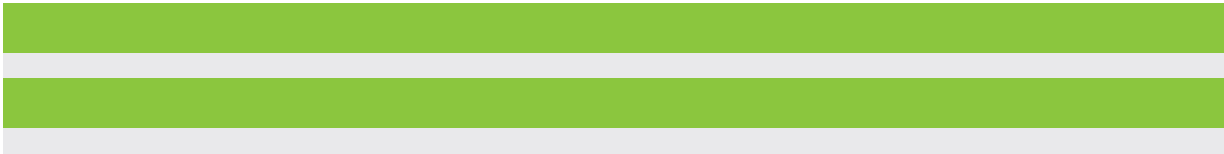
Sew together one 2.5" dark blue to a 2" bright green. Sew two sets of these together making group 1. Sew 8 of this group.



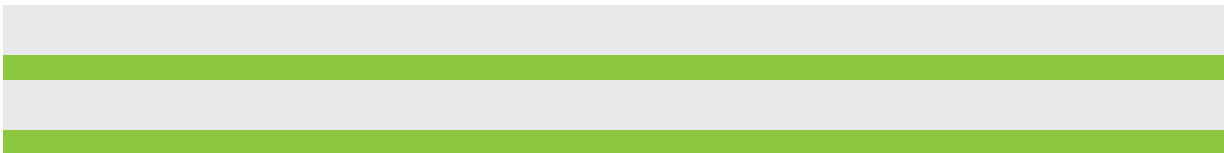
Sew together one 2.5" bright green to a 2" dark blue. Sew two sets of these together making group 2. Sew 8 of this group.



Sew together one 2.5" bright green to a 2" light gray. Sew two sets of these together making group 3. Sew 8 of this group.



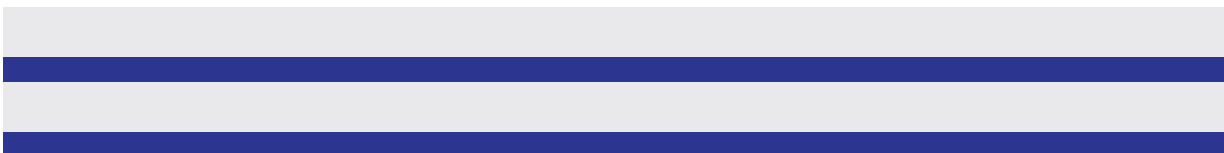
Sew together one 2.5" light gray to a 2" bright green. Sew two sets of these together making group 4. Sew 8 of this group.



Sew together one 2.5" dark blue to a 2" light gray. Sew two sets of these together making group 5. Sew 8 of this group.



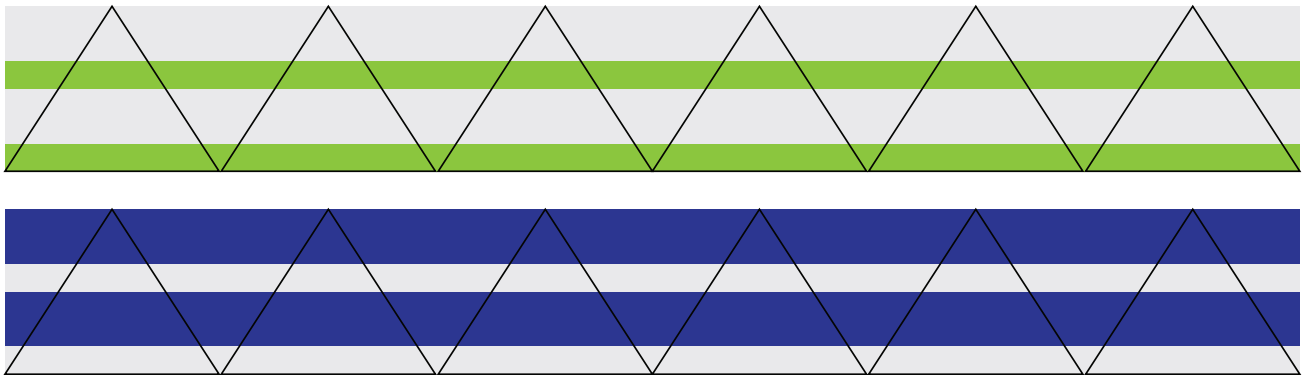
Sew together one 2.5" light gray to a 2" dark blue. Sew two sets of these together making group 6. Sew 8 of this group.



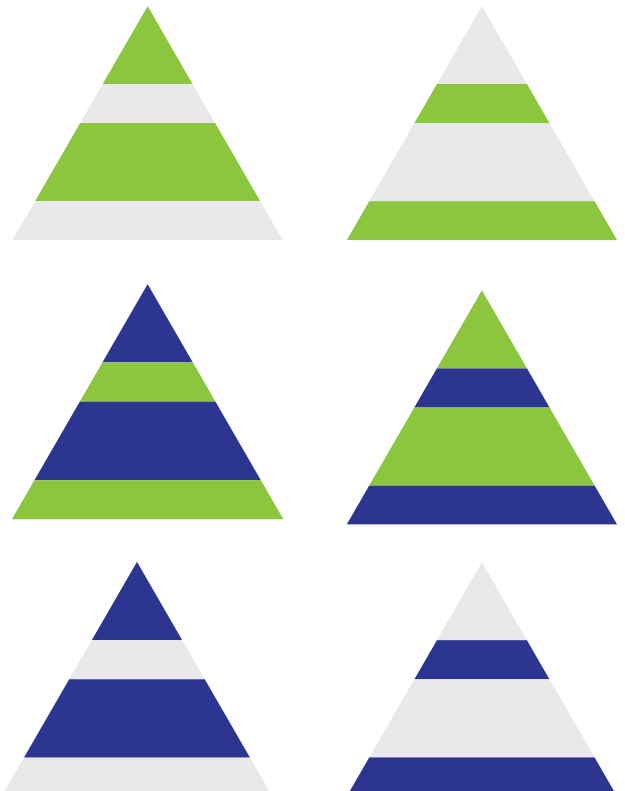
Iron groups 1-6 so the seams are flat.

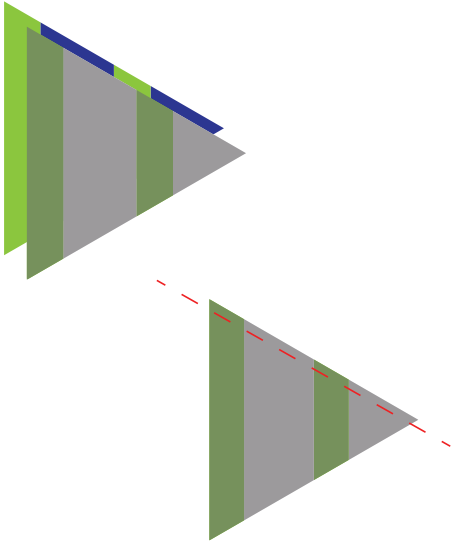
Using your 60° triangle ruler cut a triangle using 6.5" as your triangle size. You will be able to cut out 5 triangles from each set.

*If you don't want to waste the excess fabric, keep it and you can use it to make another quilt. (The quilt made from excess fabric will have a smaller box because you are making the 2" strip the point on the triangle.)

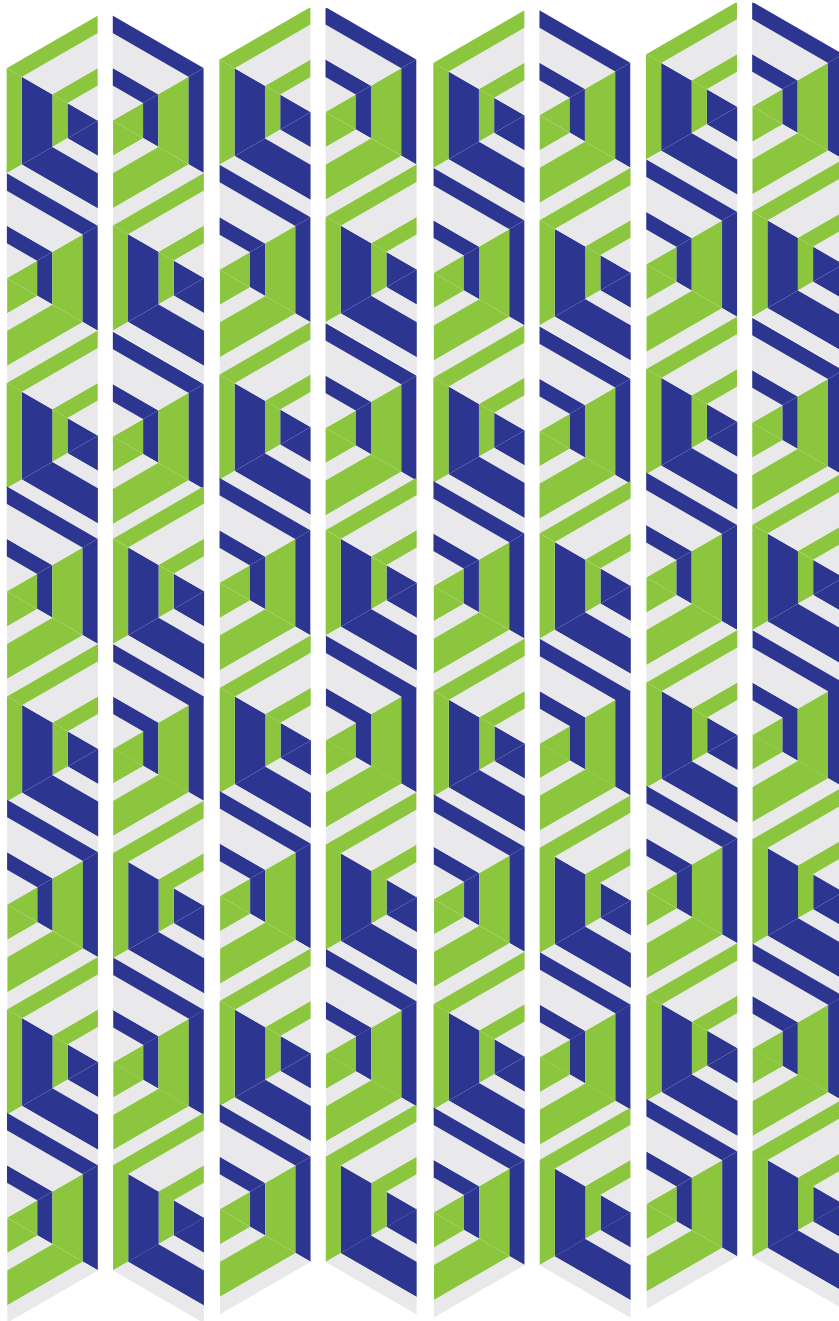


Layout triangles in group piles. You should have at least 32 triangles of each group. This will help when you layout your quilt, which is what we will be doing on the next page.



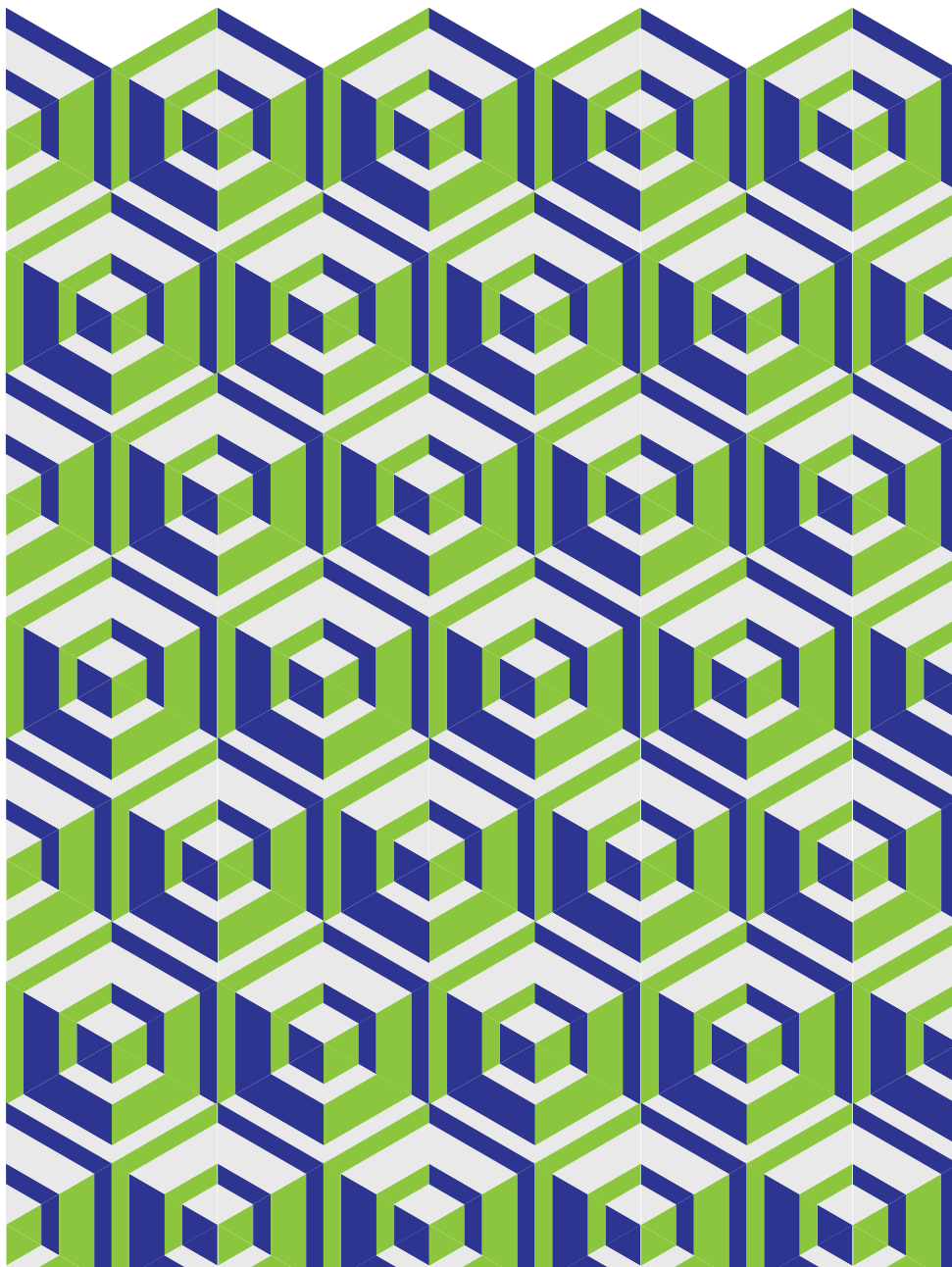


Layout your triangle blocks in rows 1-9 it helps to use a sticky note. Write on each sticky note the row number 1-top and pin it to the top triangle of each row. This will help as you sew the rows together.



Sew together rows one and two, sew three rows and four, five and six and seven and eight. Sew the rest of the rows together using a 1/4" seam allowance.

Use the ruler to cut off top and bottom to add borders. The white line is your cutting line. Remember to leave a 1/4" seam allowance as you are cutting.

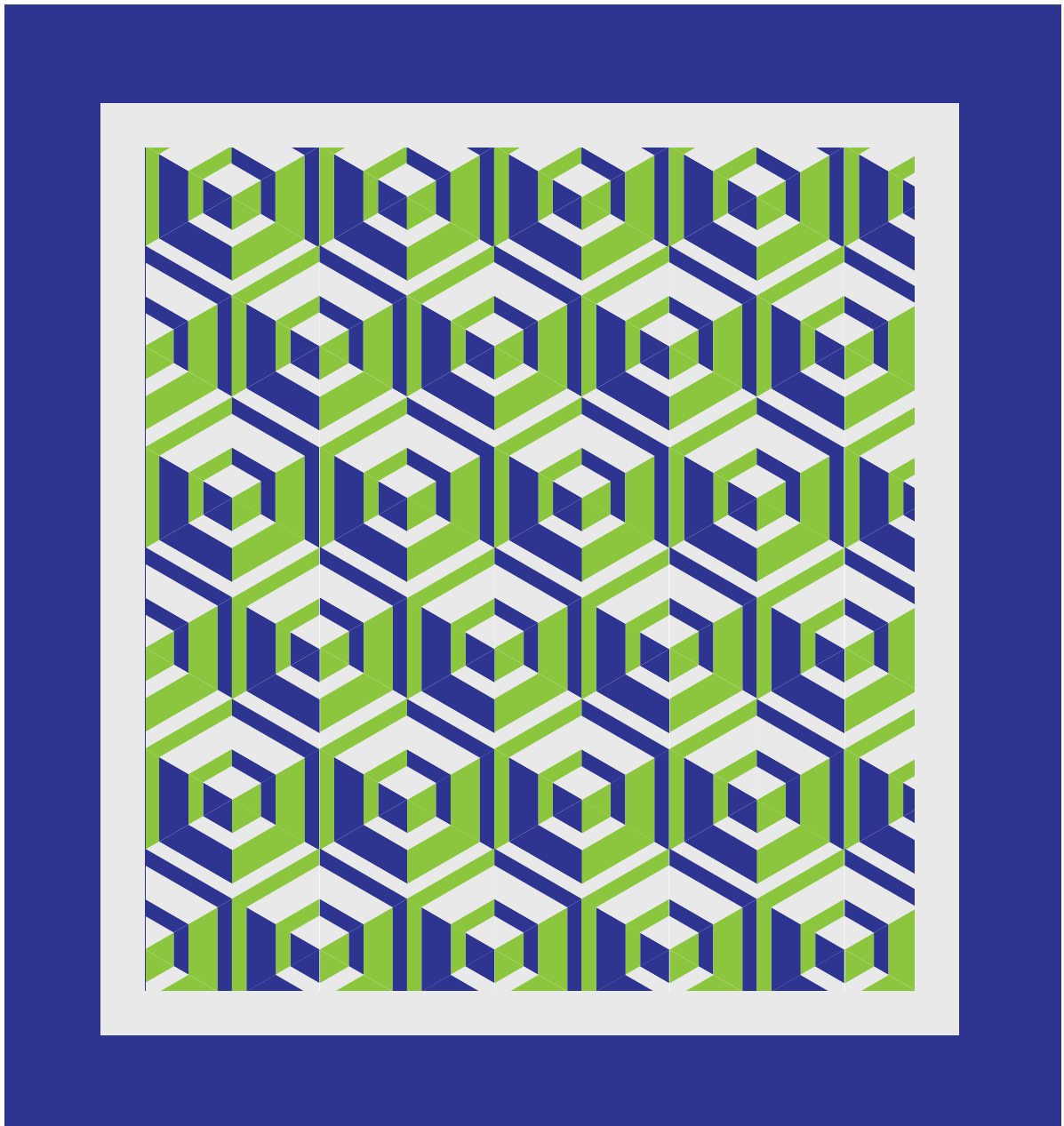


Add borders, using the light gray, cut 4 strips, 2.5" wide and 70" long. Sew side border first, then sew top and bottom. Cut off excess.

For the outer border use the dark blue and cut 4 strips, 4.5" wide and 80" long. Sew side borders first, then sew top and bottom. Cut off excess.

Now you are ready to quilt.

Looks hard but it is:
SEW EASY!
