
"Record" feature allows you to free motion a design and record your quilting. This is a fun way to add to your pattern design library. Click on "Record" and we will record your quilting free motion design.


*Note: The Record like other functions and can be used in simulation mode. In simulation mode, you can practice your design, using your mouse or a tablet pen to draw.



I will let you know what it will do, however, in this interface some of these features will not work because you don't need them.









Click on "START REACORDING" using either your sewing machine, your tablet pencil, or mouse. Draw or sew your design, once you are finished drawing or sewing your design, click on "STOP."




Not happy with your design, click on "Clear" and start over. Like your design but want to make a few edits, click on "Edit" it will take it out of the "Record" screen and send you to "PatternCAD" screen.



Inside the "PatternCAD" screen, is were you can edit your design. To learn the tools in "PatternCAD" find "Help" on the home screen. Click on "Help Topics" and find "PatternCAD." Inside "PatternCAD" you will lean about the edit functions and how to use them to edit your design.



Once you have your design ready to quilt, click on "Quilt" once you click on "Quilt" you will be prompted to "Save" your design. Save it click on "Enter" on your keypad screen or your keypad. Click on "Save" at the bottom right corner of your "Save Power Panto" screen.




Place your recorded design onto your quilt, using the placement nodes the gray dots around your design.

Move your machine to the area you want to place your design. Tap on the gray dot, and you will see part of your design move to the new location.

Now move your machine to your next placement and tap on the other node.

Moving the machine and tapping on the nodes you can adjust your design to fit exactly where you want on your quilt. Once placed then click on "Quilt" this will take you to the quilting interface screen.



Click on "Pull Bobbin" your machine will engage (pop up screen will ask if your needle is up, if it is then click OK) and move the start point of your design where the green circle is on your design. The machine will move to start point and the needle will go down and up to catch your bobbin thread. Once again you will be asked in the pop-up screen if your needle is up, if it is then click OK, the machine will move away to pull the bobbin thread up. Now that you have pulled the bobbin click on "SEW" to sew your recorded design. Once it has completed sewing, you can use the single stitch in your toolbox to pull your bobbin thread or click on "Finished" this takes your machine out of the automation and you can pull your bobbin thread using the buttons on your handles.

Inside the "Toolbox" are some useful tools to help you quilt your design.










The "Safe Area" is your "quiltable," quilting area. It will be different for every quilt. The "Safe Area" is defined by quilt size, machine throat and design. For pantograph edge-to-edge design you will want to set your safe area just off the edge of your quilt top so the design will sew off the edge slightly. How far off is determined by you and how wide your backing and batting are. Remember you always cut your backing and batting wider than your top. Let's set the safe area.





Move your machine off the quilt top to the top left corner until your machine's foot hits the take-up rail. Bring the machine forward just a slightly make sure the machine is on the batting about ½-1"off the quilt top.

When setting the "Safe Area" in "Pantograph" for an edge-to-edge design you want the design to sew off the edge of your quilt top slightly. ☐ Multi-Placement ①





3. Move your machine the width of the quilt top off the right edge onto the batting about ½-1". Now bring move the machine as far forward as you can towards the front of the frame as far forward as the machine will extend to the "BOTTOM RIGHT."





Single stitch to pull up bobbin thread

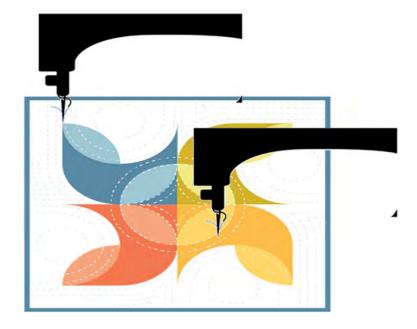
When you are in QuiltMotion mode your sewing machine functions are not available. The buttons on your machine do not work when QuiltMotion is engaged.

1. "Click" on "Single Stitch" the needle will insert down into the quilt to pull bobbin thread up. Another use for the "Single Stitch" is a tie off your thread.






When using the QuiltMotion the carriage will be locked and can't be moved manually. However, there may be times you need to repair your design- like when run out of bobbin thread, or your thread breaks. "Click" on "Release Carriage" so you can move the sewing machine out of the way. Also use this option if you need to change the bobbin.











"Adjust Point" buttons help you adjust the end point of last zone with the beginning point of a new zone. To adjust the end point click on the "Nudge Arrows" the direction you need it adjusted use small, medium or large steps to match up the end point to the start point. Matching up the points as close as possible will help your design look like one continuous design. Use the "Reset" to undo adjustments.









Release Sewing Machine

"Click" on "Release Sewing Machine" to take control of your machine manually. This allows you to check your machine's functions to make sure it is sewing correctly.






1. "Click" on "Slow Baste." Move your machine across the area you want to baste. The slower you move the machine across your quilt the smaller and closer together. The stitches will be. The faster you move your machine, the larger and further apart the stitches are.

2. "Click" on "Stop" when finished.

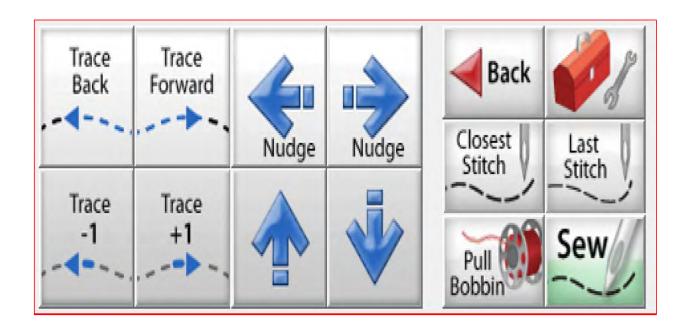
The higher the speed the faster the needle down/up is.




Quilting Interface continued... Repair Pattern




The "Repair Pattern" tools help you easily repair your design and make it look like you never stopped to repair it.




Trace Back and Trace Forward to where you position the machine on the design.




"Trace," traces over your already quilted design without the sewing machine sewing. The "Trace" features allows you to trace forward or backward to find exactly where the design stopped sewing. Finding the stitch you stopped sewing allows you start stitching seamlessly, so your design has no breaks in your stitches from where it stopped.




Move your machine to the last stitched, stitch then click on "Closest Stitch." Moving the machine near that last stitched portion of the design helps the automation find that location on the design and when you click on "Closest Stitch" it will find the nearest stitch in you design.







"Last Stitch" will take you to the last stitch, stitched on you design. This is where the sewing machine stopped. If the thread broke or you ran out of bobbin the sewing machine will keep stitching until you hit stop.



Sewing machine stopped.




Sometimes your machine might need a little "Nudge" to help it get back exactly to where you stopped stitching. If your thread broke, or your bobbin ran out and your machine kept sewing without stitching. Click on "Last Stitch" your machine will move to the last place it stopped sewing. Notice you don't have stitches, use the "Nudge" buttons to get you to the last stitched stitch.




Using the "Nudge" arrows you can move the machine in small increments to where it stopped stitching.

Quilting interface continued... Change Bobbin




Click on the "Toolbox" and then Click on "Release Carriage" inside the toolbox. Once the carriage is released move it to the side of your quilt and change the bobbin. After the bobbin is changed move the machine back to the last stitch that was stitched in your design. Click on "Closest Stitch" when you click on closest stitch your machine will engage with the automation and lock onto that stitch in the design, if your needle is in the right location on your design click on "Pull Bobbin."




Pull your bobbin thread and then click on "Sew" to finish quilting your design. Your machine will sew your to offs and continue sewing/quilting the rest of your design. Once it has stopped Click on "Finished Pattern," and pull your bobbin thread up.





"Key Status" is a text description that describes what products you as the quilter have and their registration status. It is there for our troubleshooting purposes if a you have trouble registering.





A prompt is a dialog box that prompt you to complete and action. "Would you like to save this Zone Sewing Session?" The prompt may get tiresome to quilters so you can turn it off. Click on "Do Not Show Again" and that specific prompt will not show again during your quilting session. Every time you restart your QCT5 the prompts will reappear.

Repair Kit

Operation Mode







This screen allows you to switch between the three different modes of operation:

- 1. Standard-is when your software is connected to your machine and you are quilting.
- 2. Debug-is the software is connected and running and the system had added capability of collecting and displaying data. Typically this is used by the Technical support when trouble shooting a problem or in the development side of the software.
- 3. Simulation-is when you run the software when it is not connected to your machine and quilting.





"Notifications" is one more place you can check to see if there are any updates.
