


Supported File Formats:


CMD CQP CSV DXF HQF QDATA QLI SSD TAP TXT XY...QLI or CQP suggested purchase format.

Once purchased, you can download the designs directly from the website onto your computer.

Example:

When you click on the ("Design Name Here") under the download, that design is now in your downloads file on your computer.






Another way to download your purchased designs is through your email. An email receipt is sent to you. Open the email and your designs can be downloaded from the email.

When you click on ("design name here") that design is now in your download file on your computer.




You have found your "DOWNLOADS" and the design you want to import. Notice it is a compressed file. This means there are several different file formats of the design (CMD CQP CSV DXF HQF QDATA QLI SSD TAP TXT XY) included in your purchase. Some websites will have you pick your preferred file format before you purchase, while others will have the design in several different formats.




You have found your "DOWNLOADS" and the design you want to import. "Right click" on design file the then click on "Extract All"







no longer compressed, we are ready to save our design to our USB thumb drive in the desired format.

Before we save to our USB Thumb drive, let's make a file folder so we can find them easily keep track of our files.

Before we copy our designs to our flash drive to import onto our tablet, we need to make a file folder and name it.


You can decide how you want to file arrange your designs files: by designer, design type, style, etc. Once you've made a choice, stick with it. This is a very important step. If you stick with your design filing system, you won't double purchase designs or have a hard time finding one.


This will also keep your designs separate to identify which folder it is in to import.


Plug USB Flash Drive into computer.




Find and select USB Drive (D:)









Now we can save our designs to the USB flash drive in the folder we just named. First find the folder where you saved your extracted designs.




Notice all the different file formats. Importing all the formats onto your tablet it will take up space, so choose which format you prefer. Select that format. "QLI" or "CQP" are the formats I prefer.




1. Once selected, rightclick on design file.







Choose "Copy" from the popup menu. Do not cut files or move them directly; create a copy so that if something happens to your tablet, you will have a back up.



Now open the USB Drive (D) again and click on the folder you create earlier.

With your designs downloaded onto your USB flash drive, plug your flash drive into your tablet's USB port.



Newer tablets may require an USB-C to USB adapter. If your tablet does not have a USB port, it will require this adapter.



Power on your tablet and open your QCT 5 software in "Simulation Mode."

You can open and import into several different places in QCT 5.

"Select & Sew"



We will choose "Select & Sew."











Click on "Batch Import."

























Your open "Batch" folder will show you your newly imported designs. Let's move our designs to our new filing folder.


Click on the "Back Arrow" top right corner to go back to your files so that we can create a new file for these designs.





Your new file folder is now ready to store designs. Click on the back arrow (top right) to find the batch folder and designs. We will cut them out of our "Batch Folder" and paste them into our new file folder.





Click on "Multi" and "All/None" to select all the designs.

After selecting the designs you want to place in your new folder, click on "Cut." Your designs will disappear. Click on your back arrow at the top right.
